PART 3 - PRIVACY CONSENT

You may seek to access information collected about you. Access to personal information is dealt with in accordance with the Diocese's Privacy Policy.

You may seek to have personal information corrected. Correction of personal information is dealt with in accordance with the Diocese's Privacy Policy.

You may make a complaint in accordance with the Diocese's Privacy Policy if you believe the Parish has breached the APPs. The Diocese's Privacy Policy contains information about making a complaint.
